

**ATTACHMENT 3 – ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS**

Pursuant to the PMAC General Provisions - Telecommunications Section 81, the Disentanglement (Migration-Out) CALNET 3 IFB STPD 12-001-A shall be extended for a period of 6 months starting July 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025, to allow the existing CALNET 3 customer, Cal OES, more time for contract migration. During the 6-month period, AT&T Corporation (Contractor) shall migrate-out their existing customer from CALNET 3. During this extension period for CALNET 3 migration-out purposes, the following stipulations shall apply:

1. The existing customer may utilize CALNET 3, Subcategory 1.6 Legacy Telecommunications, Sections 1.6.3.2.4 Frame Relay Features and 1.6.3.2.5 Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) Data Services, but may not order new services;
2. All CALNET 3 Individual Price Reductions shall remain in effect until the customer's migration-out process is complete;
3. Contractor shall work with their existing customer to migrate-out of the CALNET 3 Contract on or before December 31, 2025; and,
4. California Department of Technology may elect to terminate this agreement prior to the expiration date (December 31, 2025), at no additional cost to the State: (a) at the request of Contractor due to modified tariff, or (b) upon completion of customer migration-out efforts.

## Additional PMAC General Provisions - Telecommunications

### EXECUTIVE ORDER N-6-22-RUSSIA SANCTIONS

Contractor shall comply with Executive Order N-6-22 ("EO") regarding Economic Sanctions against Russia and Russian entities and individuals. "Economic Sanctions" refers to sanctions imposed by the U.S. government in response to Russia's actions in Ukraine, as well as any sanctions imposed under state law. The EO directs state agencies to terminate contracts with, and to refrain from entering any new contracts with, individuals or entities that are determined to be a target of Economic Sanctions. Accordingly, should the State determine Contractor is a target of Economic Sanctions or is conducting prohibited transactions with sanctioned individuals or entities, that shall be grounds for termination of this Contract. The State shall provide Contractor prior written notice of termination, allowing Contractor at least 30-days to provide a written response. Termination shall be at the State's sole discretion.
